

Jordan Islamic Bank Opens Its 55th Branch in Al-Thaniya

Jordan Islamic Bank celebrated the opening of its 55th branch located in Al-Thaniya/ Karak governorate to provide all banking services in accordance with the provisions and principles of Islamic Sharia; thus bringing the number of the Bank's branches to fifty-five and nine cash offices.
